Description of Category

This category is open to individuals who contribute on a regular basis as a presenter of sports news or comment, as a host of a regular sports show, a sports-event commentator, or a contributor to a sports program. Commentators are encouraged to enter this category.

Your audio should showcase your presenting ability. Judges do not want to hear an entry consisting only of a game/race call, instead entrants should show their versatility, and should, ideally, provide a selection of material and not concentrate on one particular event or program. Judges will evaluate variety, believability, knowledge of sports, presentation and entertainment value.

Entries should be no longer than 1 minute in duration and must be exactly as broadcast, no added background music or sound effects. Grabs of audio may be used from various pieces of your work/material.

Support Material Checklist

- Audio should be submitted in MP3 format
 - Maximum 1 minute in duration
 - Announce your name and station only at the start of the audio – do not announce name of category
 - Be exactly as broadcast – no added background music or sound effects.
