Description of Category

The judges will be looking for a single achievement or specific engineering project which is based on an innovative idea, demonstrates exceptional engineering skill, has broad application to the industry and/or which will achieve cost efficiencies. Supporting documentation (including photographs) is encouraged.

Requirements

Written submission (**3 page limit**)

- Include any additional supporting information

Submissions must identify;

- Nature of innovation
- Specific skills demonstrated
- State how this achievement/project will be of broad benefit to the industry
- Identify nature/degree of cost efficiency
